The activities of this year's Professional Development Committee included the following:

- The committee organized and facilitated a very successful annual PD Conference on 2 3 November 2007. This conference, which is held on the first Friday evening and Saturday morning in November, was attended by over 40 teachers. The Friday evening keynote was presented by Jennifer Finlayson, NSTU Early Intervention Officer entitled "Exploring Teacher Wellness" and Saturday morning also included a presentation by Jennifer Finlayson entitled "Time/Stress Management" followed by six professional development bell ringer sessions which were entertaining and informative.
  - The committee vetted applications for Summer Travel Fellowships, Education Research Awards, Out-Of-Province Conference Grants, and Full-time Study Grants.
  - The committee reviewed existing policies as required under Policy Review Procedures.
  - Committee met as the AVISO Editorial Advisory Board. The committee provided feedback on recent issues and selected themes and features for the 2008-09 year.
  - The committee initiated the planning for the Annual Professional Development Conference to be held on 7 and 8 November, 2008 at the Delta Halifax.
  - The committee reviewed Annual Council 2008 Professional Development Resolutions and made recommendations to Council on two of these resolutions.
  - The budget for the committee was \$7,245.00. The actual cost of the committee's business was \$2,781.10.
