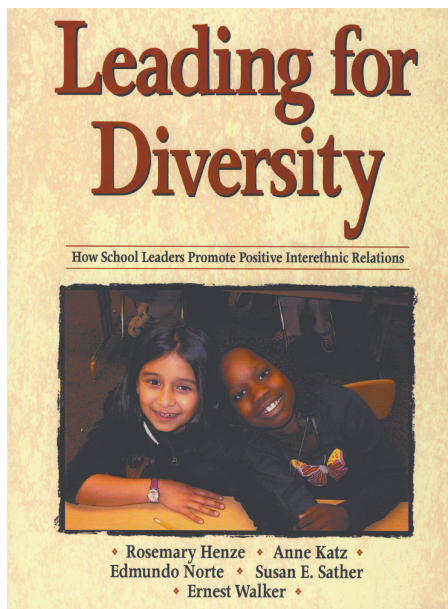


EQUITY COMMITTEE BOOK REVIEW

It is a Corwin Press publication in which the author Rosemary Henze and her team of researchers deal with the issue of race relations.  - create and implement a plan for promoting positive interethnic relations
 - document the effectiveness of your plan
